SUPPORT ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SOURCES AND OPPOSE BUILDING NEW COAL-FIRED POWER PLANTS IN NEVADA

Background:

Several new coal-fired power plants have been proposed in Nevada despite the fact that Nevada has no coal.

Proponents claim that the new plants are clean--ignoring the fact that these plants generate huge quantities of carbon dioxide, the principal constituent of greenhouse gases. The technology to build clean coal-gasification plants at altitudes over 2,000 feet does not exist.
