

**NOTE:** For some of these Resolutions, such as No.1 which has already been sent to you via a special mailing, there are very specific deadlines, and TO BE TRULY EFFECTIVE, YOUR RESPONSE ON BEHALF OF THE FEDERATION MUST BE SENT TO THE PROPER OFFICIALS IN A TIMELY MANNER!

The Resolutions Committee has given much thought and effort to making it convenient for FWOC Member Clubs and individual members to send Resolutions to the appropriate parties.

The "format" of each Resolution consist of the wording in the top half that is designated for the "targets" of the resolution. Below the dotted line is information in *italics* on how to contact the "targets," which is NOT intended to be sent; it's only for the use of the FWOC responder. The information above the dotted line should be copied at the local photocopy shop which can leave blank space above or below the text of the Resolution for comments by the FWOC person making the response. Also provided is a "Listing" of the names and addresses of most of the "targets" to which a copy of the "above Resolution" and pertinent personal comments is to be sent.

Some FWOC members and Member Clubs do not appreciate how influential a letter from us can be in reaching the minds (and hearts?) of the "decision-makers!" Political figures (the good ones, at least) are fond of hearing from (and quoting from) "grass-roots" citizens, VOTING citizens, and THAT'S US! Instead of a narrow viewpoint that is characteristic of some organizations, we represent a great variety of interests as can be noted in the FWOC letterhead, the Information Brochure, or issues of OUTDOORS WEST.
