**REAFFIRM FWOC RESOLUTION 2008-9
(Opposition to proposed liquid natural gas facilities at Bradwood Landing, Warrenton and Coos Bay, Oregon and related pipeline construction)**

Background: Although significantly weakened by political pressure from the public and environmental groups, this proposal for LNG facilities and pipelines has lived on. The latest proposals for pipeline alternative routings through the Warm Springs Reservation or through the community of Maupin at the Deschutes River crossing, have raised significant concerns from a broad coalition of local and national environmental groups. They should be opposed along with any other late-arriving proposals prior to the release of the draft EIS.

Proposed Resolution: The FWOC Re-affirms FWOC Resolution 2008-9 and continues to oppose the proposed LNG facilities at Bradwood Landing, Warrenton and Coos Bay, Oregon and related pipeline construction.
